

6D MELBOURNE AND FARMSTAY (AU06Z)

Itinerary

Day 1 SINGAPORE - MELBOURNE

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to **Melbourne**.

Day 2 MELBOURNE - FARMSTAY (Meals on Board/Western Lunch/Western Dinner)

Upon arrival in Melbourne, embark on a brief city tour and drive past **Parliament House** and **Shrine of Remembrance**. View the **Victorian Arts Centre**, **St Patrick's Cathedral** and experience the bustling activities along **Yarra River**. Later, transfer to your **farmstay**, the perfect opportunity to experience Aussie hospitality firsthand. Depending on the focus of your host farm, you can indulge in farm activities like milking cows, collecting chicken eggs, horse grooming and picking fruits, berries and vegetables amidst the rural environment. This is an educational and enriching experience for all ages.

Note

Accommodation at the farmstay is without air condition, based on multi-share and travellers will be assigned to different hosts. Please bring along an overnight bag. Farm activities may vary, depending on the farm. You may wish to bring a thank-you gift for your host.

Day 3 FARMSTAY - BALLARAT - MELBOURNE - PHILLIP ISLAND - MELBOURNE (Breakfast/Chinese Dinner)

This morning, travel to **Ballarat Wildlife Park**, where you can pose for photographs with cuddly koalas. Feed the roaming kangaroos and meet wombats, Tasmanian devils, crocodiles and other creatures. Thereafter, transfer to Melbourne to spend some time at leisure. In the evening, head to the **Penguin Reserve** on **Phillip Island** to watch the popular **penguin parade** and visit **Nobbies Centre**. Behold the spectacular sight of groups of penguins returning ashore to their sand burrows after feeding at sea. Return to Melbourne for your overnight stay.

Note

Please bring along warm clothing as Phillip Island can get cold at night.

Days 4 MELBOURNE - MORNINGTON PENINSULA - MELBOURNE (Breakfast/Lunch)

After breakfast, enjoy a scenic ride towards **Mornington Peninsula**. Visit **Sunny Ridge Strawberry Farm**, one of Australia's largest farms where you can try picking strawberries if they are in season. Take the opportunity to indulge in delectable strawberry ice-cream. Later, discover Australia's oldest hedge maze at **Ashcombe Maze** and look out for the rose maze with over 1,200 varieties of roses. Later, make a stop at **Lavender Gardens** to delight your senses with the fragrance and sight of these lovely flowers and learn how lavender oil is distilled. Thereafter, visit **Willow Creek Vineyard** for some **wine tasting**.

Day 5 **MELBOURNE (Breakfast)**

After breakfast, spend the day at leisure. Join an optional tour to Great Ocean Road, one of the world's most spectacular coastal routes, at your own expense. If you are interested in the glorious history of the gold rush era, go on an optional tour to Sovereign Hill in Ballarat, at your own expense. Experience the daily rituals of the gold-mining days with a stroll down the streets to visit the goldsmiths, craftsmen and traders. Alternatively, you may wish to visit Docklands, one of Melbourne's newest attractions, a unique waterfront development in the heart of Melbourne comprising 200 hectares of land and water and 7 kilometres of waterfront

Day 6 **MELBOURNE - SINGAPORE (Breakfast/Meals on Board)**

If time permits, you can do some last-minute shopping before you transfer to the airport for your flight home.
